Job Description

POSITION OVERVIEW:

Under the direction of the Aquatics Manager, the swim coach is responsible for planning and coaching swim practices for members and non-members of Jewish For Good. Swim coaches must demonstrate strong customer skills with a positive, energetic, and outgoing personality.

This front line, part-time seasonal (hourly) position reports to our Aquatics and Recreation Manager.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- To lead as a positive example of the Jewish Community Center and as a swim coach.
- To treat all children, members, guests, coworkers, lifeguards, etc. with respect.
- Flexible with coaching any age group. Every coach may have an "assigned" group, but throughout the season you will most likely work with those who can and cannot swim.
- Get in the water with the children during practice and help correct their strokes.
- Make sure the children are safe and teach them safety rules.
- Help with the set up with swim meets and willing to get to the swim meets early.
- Help with the preparation before and after swim meets (cards, awards, etc).
- Help with daily set up and cleanup of the pool.
- Show up to shifts on time.
- Ability to perform activities which require sustained concentration and attention.
- Ability to sit or stand for long periods of time.

Qualifications

Required Qualifications:

- Ability to teach competitive swimming to a wide variety of age groups/skill levels
- At least 1 year of competitive swimming, coaching, and/or instructional experience
- A lifeguard certification is preferred but not required
